

HOW TO MAKE THE BEST USE OF LITTER

CLUMPING MINERALS INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

01

FILLING THE TRAY

When opening a new bag, **fill the tray** (already cleaned and sanitised) with **5/7 cm** of litter. The layer must be deep enough for the cat to dig, but not too deep.



02

REMOVAL OF CLUMPS

Remove solid clumps as they form. Be sure to carry out this process regularly to ensure **optimal hygiene** and odour control.



03

REFILLING WITH LITTER

When you remove clumps, the litter level gets lower. When it falls below the ideal level, take care to refill the tray with some new litter.



04

CHANGING THE LITTER

Replace the litter completely when necessary, taking care to wash the tray thoroughly with soap and water before filling it with new litter.



05

DISPOSAL

Bentonite is a clay mineral and can be disposed of in your **household waste**. Before you throw it away, **always be sure to check your local regulations** regarding the disposal of litter and its packaging.



ABSORBENT LITTER, NORMAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

FILLING THE TRAY

REMOVAL OF FAECES

Urasite is a clay mineral and can be disposed of in your **household waste**. Before you throw it away, **always be sure to check your local regulations** regarding the disposal of litter and its packaging.



ABSORBENT LITTER IN SILICA GEL INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

01

FILLING THE TRAY

When opening a new bag, **fill the tray** (already cleaned and sanitised) with **4/5 cm** of litter. The layer must be deep enough for the cat to dig, but not too deep.



02

REMOVAL OF FAECES

Faeces must be removed daily with the shovel. The litter will stay perfectly **hygienic and dry**.



03

LITTER REPLACEMENT

The litter typically lasts for the time listed in the product info sheet. Once this time has elapsed, we recommend removing all the litter, washing the tray thoroughly with soap and water, and filling it with new litter.

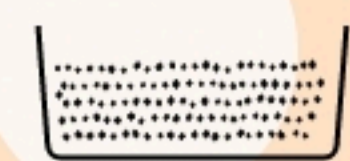
DISPOSAL

Silica gel litter can be disposed of in your **household waste**. Before you throw it away, **always be sure to check your local regulations** regarding the disposal of cat litter.



PLANT-BASED CLUMPING LITTER INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

FILLING THE TRAY

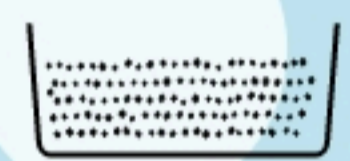

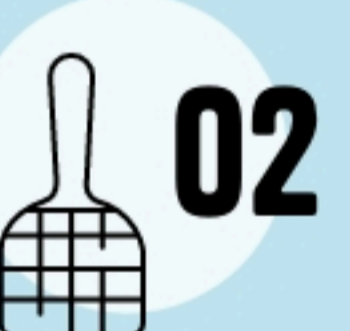
